

## Standard and Staff

Normandale Preschool is licensed through the Department of Human Services and The Evangelical Lutheran Education Association. We are licensed to serve 75 students per session with a total enrollment of 150 students. The student/teacher ratio is no more than 1 to 10 for children ages three to five years.

Our teachers are well educated early childhood professionals who model their Christian faith daily within the classroom. All participate in programs of continuing education for professional advancements in Early Childhood Education.

### Our Facility

As a ministry of Normandale Lutheran Church, the preschool has access to the Normandale Church facility. Areas used for special events include the kitchen, fellowship hall, meeting rooms and sanctuary. Spaces used daily/weekly include:

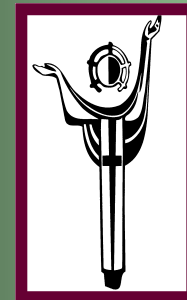

## Mission Statement

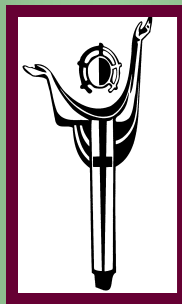
